| Easter Baskets or Bags | <input type="checkbox"/> Loan baskets to children who forget to bring their own, or provide festive gift bags as party favors.   |
| Permanent Ink Marker   | <input type="checkbox"/> To number the Resurrection Eggs.  |
| Name Tags              | <input type="checkbox"/> If young ones are tempted to peel them off, place the tags on their backs.  |

| Clean-up Supplies      | <input type="checkbox"/> Wipes for chocolate-covered fingers<br><input type="checkbox"/> Trash bags for candy wrappers<br><input type="checkbox"/> Spray cleaner<br><input type="checkbox"/> Stain removal spray<br><input type="checkbox"/> Other: _____<br><input type="checkbox"/> Other: _____   |
| Chairs                 | <input type="checkbox"/> Not enough? Ask adult guests to bring their lawn chairs.  |
