- 4. Provide a free evening of childcare for a stressed couple.
- **5.** Bring a warm beverage to someone working outside: construction workers, kids shoveling drives, etc.
- **6.** Invite a couple of kids from the neighborhood to make cookies or decorate your tree.
- **7.** Offer to decorate for someone physically unable.
- 8. Invite an international family or student to your festivities or another student who can't go home.

- **9.** Call, text, or leave the flyer below for neighbors asking them to donate coats, hats, blankets etc. (Plan on washing and drying all cloth items.)
- **10.** Invite a neighbor to help you create care bundles for the homeless.
- 11. Bake cookies or make crafts with a neighbor.
- 12. Shovel neighbors' snowy driveways.
- **13.** Visit with someone at a nursing home (staff may be able to make recommendations).
- 14. Pass out inexpensive mugs with packaged cider, hot chocolate, and/or small coffee packets tucked inside; you might include a wrapped candy cane. Use our printable gift tags below.
